
Clubs are available to book tonight via magic booking. See page 3 for the waiting list approach we have introduced.



Some of you eagle-eyed parents may have noticed our shiny new clothes recycling bin has arrived!


This is available to use at any time and is a replacement to Bag2School. It will emptied fortnightly so you'll have ample opportunity to donate your clothes.


Please make sure items are bagged and that only accepted items are placed inside.




Wraparound Care (Night Owls / Early Birds)

How can a parent book onto the waiting list?

When a parent books a full session, they will see a blue Waiting List status in the Check Availability stage of booking.



Night owls will now have a digital waiting list active on Magicbooking as a trial for this half term following the increased demand from last half term.

If club is full, you can add yourself to the waiting list (please see left image).

If a space becomes available the first child on to the waiting list will take the space and a booking confirmation will be sent to inform the parent a booking has been made with an attached invoice.


