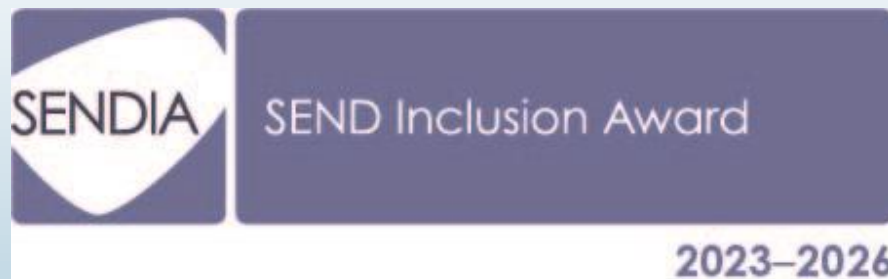

Some of you eagle-eyed parents may have noticed our shiny new clothes recycling bin has arrived!

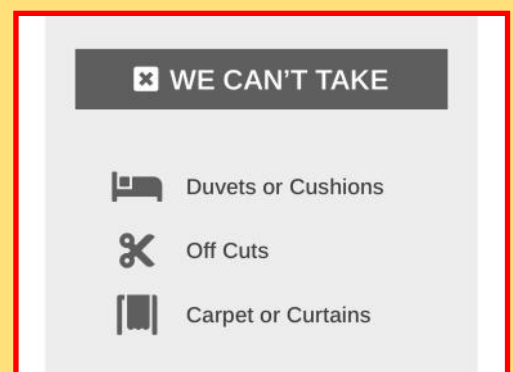
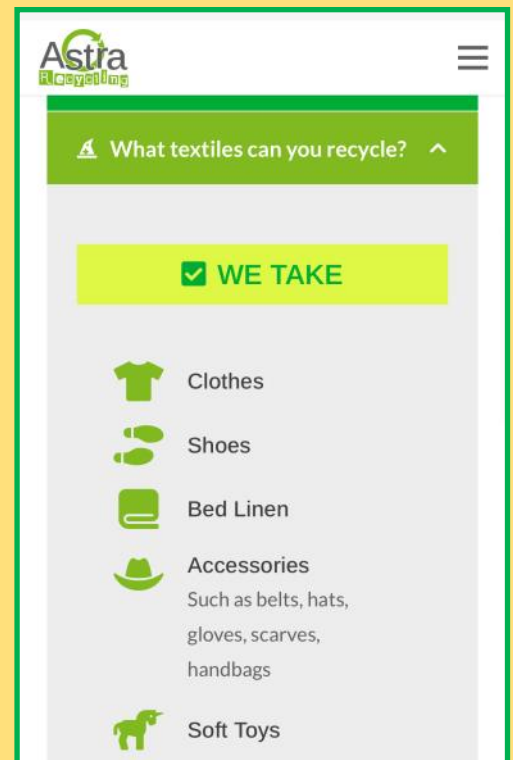
This is available to use at any time and is a replacement to Bag2School. It will be emptied fortnightly so you'll have ample opportunity to donate your clothes.

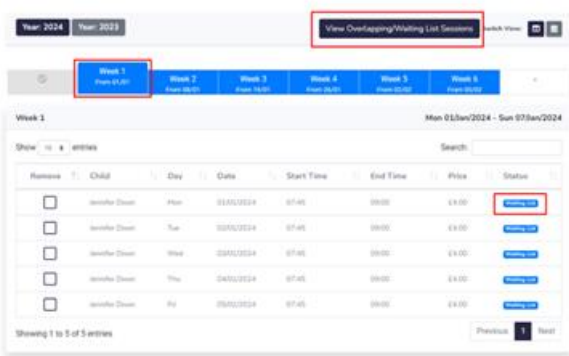


Wraparound Care (Night Owls / Early Birds)

Sessions for next half term will be available to book from Friday 18th October at 15:00 via Magicbookings

How can a parent book onto the waiting list?

When a parent books a full session, they will see a blue **Waiting List** status in the **Check Availability** stage of booking.



Night owls will now have a digital waiting list active on Magicbooking as a trial for this half term following the increased demand from last half term.

If club is full, you can add yourself to the waiting list (please see left image).

If a space becomes available the first child on to the waiting list will take the space and a booking confirmation will be sent to inform the parent a booking has been made with an attached invoice.

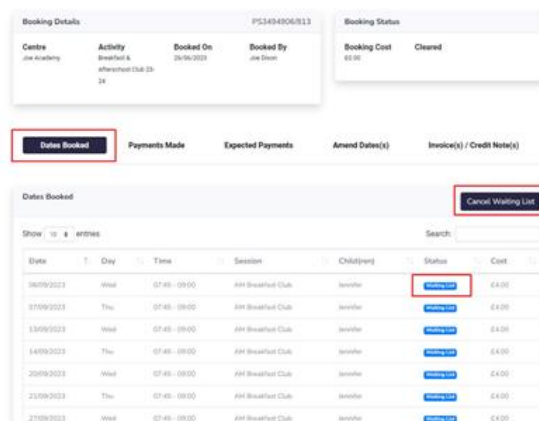
How to cancel waiting list
