Walking

You are invited to arrange the sharing of lifts but please do advise the school in advance so we are able to release children. If you would like to collect your child directly from St Michael and St Mary Magdalene Church please do so promptly at 2:20pm, once the event is over. There is a gravel car park available: St Michael and St Mary Magdalene Church, Crowthorne Rd, Easthampstead, Bracknell RG12 7EH.
