Please make every effort to stick to uniform colours of grey and light blue including for PE days! If it is your child's birthday then we celebrate in own clothes.


If your child needs adaptations to the uniform you must inform us and please work with us. Any adaptations should also be in school colours. Uniform check date is Friday 28th.

## Update on sQuid / Parent apps

We currently use sQuid for trips, parent communications and managing our lunch purses (for children in Y3-6). We are writing to inform you that sQuid will no longer be in use from 13th March onwards. Following a significant change in their payment system, they are withdrawing their services and we are working hard to source a replacement.

While we predict this may cause some minor disruption, we want to assure you that we are actively working to implement a new and improved app that will better serve the needs of our school community.

#### What does this mean for parents?

**Refunds:** sQuid are responsible for returning any unused money in your catering or trips account. We are waiting to hear if they will require an email requesting a refund or if this will be carried out automatically. We will update you when we know more, including a planned 'switchover' date.

**Debtors:** There are minimal accounts in arrears as you should prepay for lunch. But if your catering purse has arrears please do make a payment to level your account before this debt is passed on.

**Reducing our apps:** Hooray! One positive from this change is the shared desire to reduce the number of apps we use (think: parents evening, communications, trips, catering etc)

**Communication:** Things might look a bit different for a short while, please bear with us and we will do the absolute best that we can to get the important messages to you in a sensible fashion.

Our goal is to provide a user-friendly platform for communication, updates, and resources, and we are committed to selecting an app that enhances your experience as parents and guardians. In the coming weeks, we will share more details regarding the transition and provide information on how to download and navigate the new app.

We appreciate your understanding and patience as we make this transition. Should you have any questions or concerns, please do pop into the office and hopefully we will have an answer for you. Once our replacement system has been secured, we will certainly offer some parent training sessions to help get started.




