## What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?

"My daddy has packed my favourite sandwiches," Aria says.




#### What happens when I need to go to the toilet?

"Yes, Omari. Thank you for asking so **nicely,"** his teacher says. "Let me know if you need any help."




When you use the toilet, you will see that everything is just the right size for you and it is easy to use.

When a teacher sees your grown-up, they will say your name and you can walk to your grown-up. Omari's mum is here to take him home. "Goodbye everyone," he says. "I can't wait to come back and play with you tomorrow."
